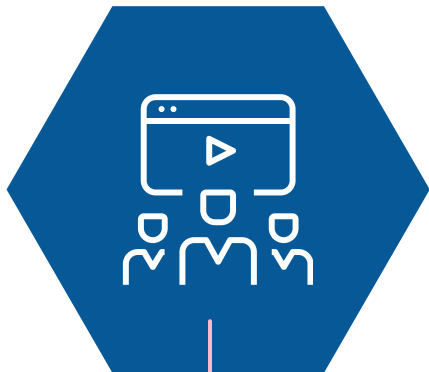

# 10 TIPS

## Planning & Organizing



Before you start, have a clear plan for your video. Use a mind map or a simple storyboard to show the video flow. Organize your clips in the order you want to edit them. This saves time and makes editing easier.

## Start with Basics (Trimming & Cutting)

Focus on simple techniques like trimming and cutting first. Learning these basics lets you make clean drafts and move to more advanced effects later.



## Ensure High-Quality Audio & Video

Record high-quality video and clear audio. Good editing cannot fully fix bad video or sound. Use noise reduction if needed.



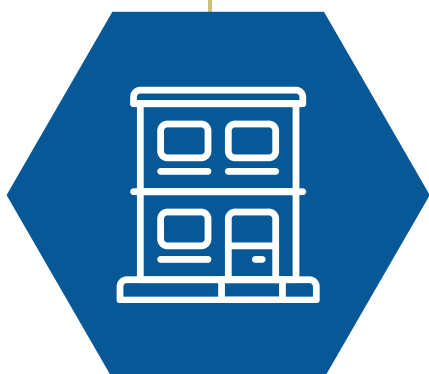
## Remove Unused Footage & Stabilize Shaky Clips

Check your footage carefully and delete clips you don't need. Use stabilization tools to fix shaky parts and make your video look professional.



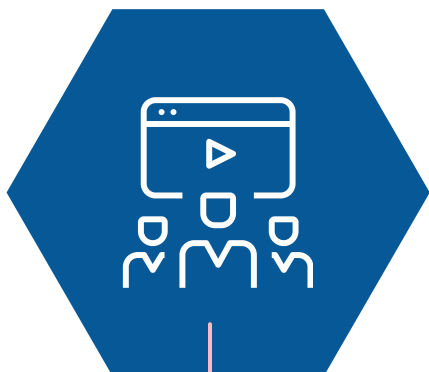
## Use Transitions Sparingly

Use simple cuts or fades to show a change in scene or time. Do not use too many transitions, as they can distract viewers.



# 10 TIPS

## Pacing & Color Scheming



Adjust the speed of your video to keep viewers interested. Improve visuals with color grading to make your video more attractive and match your brand style.

## Edit Audio & Video Separately

Keep audio and video on separate tracks. Sync dialogue, music, and sound effects separately for a professional result.



## Use B-Roll Shots in Sets of Three

Add extra footage (B-roll) to make your story stronger. Group B-roll shots in sets of three for variety and smooth flow.



## Use Split Edits

Split edits let you start audio slightly before or after the video. This improves transitions and keeps viewers engaged.
