TARGET GROUPS

Young participants

Aged between 15 and 29, particularly those with fewer opportunities, who are under-represented in decision-making processes.

Youth Workers & Educators

Professionals in youth work, formal and non-formal education.

Organisations & Institutions

Civil society organisations, local authorities, schools, NGOs. Institutional facilitators for the adoption of results and strategic partners in amplifying impact.

European Multipliers

Policy-makers, European networks, Erasmus+ platforms, researchers, international NGOs.

WHAT IS CIVIC VOICES?

It is an Erasmus+ project that believes young people have the power to transform society — making it more inclusive, democratic and resilient.

HOW?

Bringing together young people from four countries in a programme that combines civic education with real opportunities to influence policy.

TO THIS END, THE PROJECT IS BASED ON FOUR OBJECTIVES:

- **Civic participation** — Workshops, democratic labs and youth-led initiatives
- **Citizenship skills** — Training in critical thinking, media literacy and rights, using the Voices into Action Toolkit
- **Transnational collaboration** — Young people from Italy, the Netherlands, Portugal and the Czech Republic in dialogue and co-creation
- **A voice in politics** — Co-creation of the Peace in Action Youth Manifesto, to be presented in Brussels
